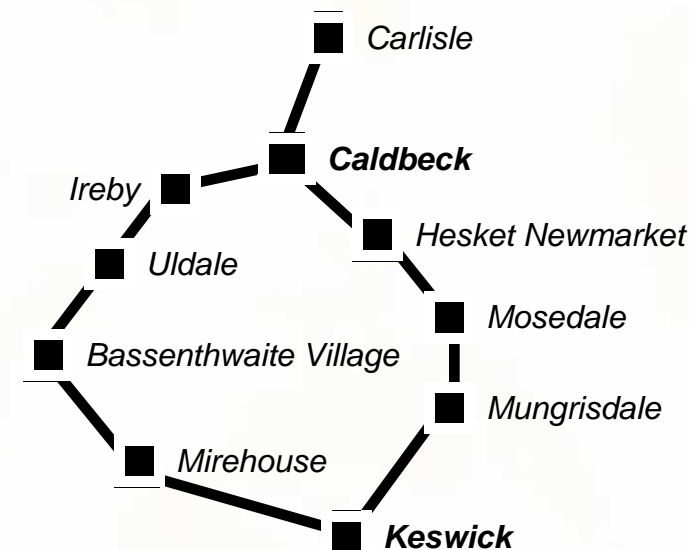

Places to Visit

Caldbeck Attractive village with pub, tea room, Priests Mill with waterwheel, craft centre and tea room, village shop, Third World Shop, clogmakers and old map shop.

Hesket Newmarket Picturesque village with pub, shop and tea room.

Mirehouse Historic house and gardens, in beautiful situation, with many literary connections. 'Phone a Tourist Information Centre for details of opening.

The Ospreys are back.

The Lake District's first breeding ospreys reared a chick in 2001. Join the Lake District Osprey Project Team at the Dodd Wood viewpoint (near Mirehouse) for spectacular views of the nest and their fishing ground on Bassenthwaite Lake, or at Whinlatter with its displays and CCTV pictures of the nest .

Keswick has a wide range of attractions including museums, shops, parks and cruises/boat hire on Derwentwater.

Castlerigg Stone Circle. Ancient site with panoramic views.

The main bus stops are shown on the timetable but outside Carlisle and Keswick, the Caldbeck Rambler will stop to pick up passengers anywhere safe off main roads.
